



Building Permit Extension Request

IBC Section 105.5 and IRC Section R105.5 Expiration: Every permit issued shall become invalid unless the work authorized by such permit is commenced within 180 days after its issuance, or if the work authorized by such permit is suspended or abandoned for a period of 180 days after the time the work is commenced. The building official is authorized to grant, in writing, one or more extensions of time, for periods not more than 180 days each. The extension shall be requested in writing and justifiable cause demonstrated. (A fee of \$120, under UFS 9027, will be required for additional extensions after the first extension.)

Note: Per UFS 2843 all permits and applications are subject to a 3% Technology fee. The 3% fee is calculated on the permit/application fees due.
