#### **INITIATIVE TO THE PEOPLE 900**

The Whatcom County Council passed Resolution No. 2005-043 concerning a proposition to authorize a sales and use tax as allowed by law and for the provision of countywide emergency medical services. This ballot proposition would authorize the imposition of a sales and use tax, in addition to any other taxes authorized by law, of one-tenth of one percent (0.1% -- 10 cents for every \$100), two-thirds to be used solely for costs associated with the provision of countywide emergency medical services and one-third for criminal justice purposes, as authorized by RCW 82.14.450.
