ORDINANCE NO. 92-023

RENAMING THE LARRY MOUNT REVOLVING FUND TO THE COUNTY SHERIFF REVOLVING FUND

WHEREAS, prior actions by the Board of County Commissioners established a discretionary account for use by the County Sheriff in the pursuit of official duties, and;

WHEREAS, prior practice used the name of the duly elected Sheriff to identify the account, and;


WHEREAS, upon change of administration in the County Sheriffs office it becomes legally unacceptable for the new duly elected Sheriff to use the subject account without specific action by the County Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Whatcom County Council that, henceforth, the Larry Mount Revolving Fund shall be known as the County Sheriff Revolving Fund, and such fund shall be provided for use by the duly elected and sworn County Sheriff.


