11 **DECLARING AN EMERGENCY REGARDING**  
12 **ESTABLISHMENT OF PARKING CONTROL ON LUMMI VIEW DRIVE**  
13 **DURING THE DRY-DOCKING OF THE WHATCOM CHIEF**  
14

15  
16 **WHEREAS**, the Whatcom County Council is authorized under RCW 46.61.570  
17 to restrict parking on certain County roads; and  
18

20 **WHEREAS**, the County Public Works Department has recently completed shoulder  
21 widening along the southerly shoulder of Lummi View Drive to provide temporary  
22 parking space for vehicles during those periods the Lummi Island Ferry is out of service;  
23 and

26 **WHEREAS**, use of the southerly shoulder of Lummi View Drive for parking of  
27 vehicles, other than for emergency purposes, is undesirable when the Lummi Island Ferry  
28 remains in operation; and

31 **WHEREAS**, passage of this emergency ordinance is necessary for the immediate  
32 preservation of the public peace, health or safety or support of the county government  
33 and its existing institutions; and

36 **WHEREAS**, as an emergency ordinance this document will expire as of the 61st  
37 day following the date on which the ordinance becomes law, pursuant to Whatcom  
38 County Home Rule Charter Section 2.40;

41 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, that a No Parking Without Permit At  
42 Anytime, Tow Away Zone be established on the Southerly shoulder of Lummi View  
43 Drive, from 100 feet westerly of Finkbonner Road to Lena Street, Section 3 Township  
44 37 North Range 1 East and Section 34 Township 38 North Range 1 East. This parking  
45 restriction does not apply to those vehicles with properly displayed permits issued by the  
46 Department of Public Works to users of the Lummi Island Ferry during times that the  
47 Lummi Island ferry is out of service and temporary parking is required, except that the  
48 No Parking provisions within this Ordinance shall remain in force for any vehicle not  
49 displaying the appropriate permit.

1 The County Engineer is hereby directed to post and maintain appropriate signs and the  
2 Whatcom County Sheriff and the Washington State Patrol shall be notified by a copy  
3 of this ordinance.  
4

5 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, that the permit parking shall  
6 be available only for so long as the Whatcom Chief is in drydock.  
7

8 Provisions of this ordinance are hereby added to Whatcom County Code Section  
9 10.24.  
10

11 **ADOPTED** this 28th day of April, 1992.




