7 AN ORDINANCE REGARDING THE MATTER OF
8 REMOVING STOP SIGNS ON HAMPTON ROAD

10 WHEREAS, in compliance with RCW 46.61.200 and 47.36.110, it is found
11 necessary and expedient to remove traffic control signs on certain County Roads;
12 and

14 WHEREAS, upon notification from the Burlington Northern Railroad that they
15 have abandoned the two railroad crossings on the Hampton Road;

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that stop signs eastbound and
18 westbound on Hampton Road at the Burlington Northern railroad crossings be
19 removed; Section 19, Township 40 North, Range 4 East, W.M.
20

21 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the County Engineer is hereby directed
22 to remove the appropriate signs and that the Whatcom County Sheriff and the
23 Washington State Patrol be notified by a copy of this ordinance.
