ORDINANCE NO. 93-067

AMENDING THE WHATCOM COUNTY CODE TO REPEAL  
CHAPTER 5.56, TEENAGE DANCES

WHEREAS, Whatcom County Code Chapter 5.56 contains requiring formation of a teenage dance board and a permitting process for such dances; and

WHEREAS, this section of law was carried over from the prior form of County government, based on legislation enacted in 1964; and

WHEREAS, the teenage dance board is not in existence, nor does the County engage in the permitting of teenage dances; and

WHEREAS, it is good policy for the Council to eliminate sections of the Code that are no longer relevant;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Whatcom County Council that Chapter 5.56 of the Whatcom County Code is hereby repealed in its entirety.
