
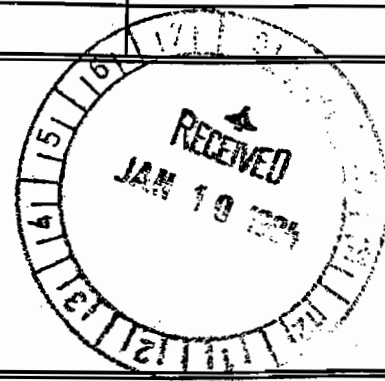

ORDINANCE NO. 94-01

AN ORDINANCE REGARDING THE MATTER OF  
ESTABLISHING THE SPEED LIMIT ON SUCIA DRIVE

WHEREAS, the Whatcom County Council is authorized under RCW 46.61.415 to establish speed limits on certain County roads; and

WHEREAS, an engineering study has been conducted by the County Engineer's office and reviewed by the Sheriff's office.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that the speed limits be established as follows:


- 1) 25 mph on Sucia Drive for the entire length, Section 5 and 8, Township 38 North, Range 1 East, W.M.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the County Engineer is hereby directed to post the appropriate signs and that the Whatcom County Sheriff and the Washington State Patrol be notified by a copy of this ordinance.

Provisions of this ordinance are hereby added to Whatcom County Code Section 10.04.030.

ADOPTED this 4th day of January, 1994.




