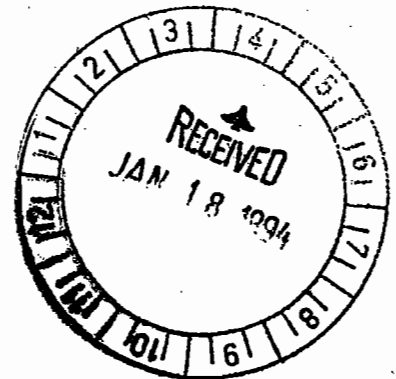

The public will be given two weeks notice by advertisement in the County's legal newspaper, and an opportunity to compete for the item's purchase by mailed bids. The advertisement shall describe the vehicle and state the negotiated sale price. The vehicle shall not be sold to any County employee or a member of an employee's family.

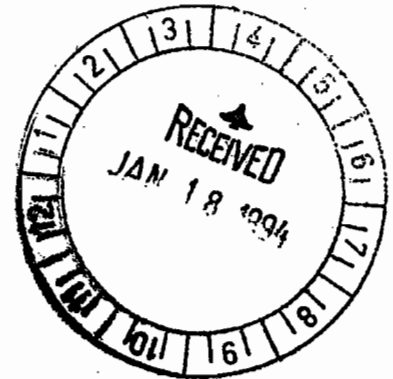


