RESOLUTION NO. 94-020

SUPPORTING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A P.A.C.E. LANE FOR THE
POINT ROBERTS BORDER CROSSING

WHEREAS, crossings at the Point Roberts international border have become burdensome and onerous for American and Canadian residents of Point Roberts alike; and

WHEREAS, traffic changes investigated by the Transportation Services Department are likely to only slightly mitigate the problem; and

WHEREAS, the institution of the P.A.C.E. lane program at other international crossings has proven to be a significant improvement; and

WHEREAS, residents of Point Roberts have requested that a P.A.C.E. lane crossing be implemented to help alleviate the congestion they face;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Whatcom County Council that we do hereby support the establishment of a P.A.C.E. lane at the Point Roberts crossing and urge the appropriate Canadian and American officials and agencies to swiftly establish this program which will benefit citizens of both nations.


