ORDINANCE NO. 95-002

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE DURATION OF
WHATCOM COUNTY LAKE MANAGEMENT DISTRICT NO. 1,
A LAKE MANAGEMENT DISTRICT FOR LAKE SAMISH

WHEREAS, Whatcom County Lake Management District No. 1 was created on January 28, 1992, by Ordinance No. 92-006, as proposed in Resolution 91-051; and

WHEREAS, the initial duration of said district was for a period of three years from the date of its creation; and

WHEREAS, per RCW 36.61 a lake management district may be created for a period of up to ten years; and

WHEREAS, the need exists to extend the duration of said district, for maintenance and operations activities, beyond the initial expiration date; and

WHEREAS, no additional special assessments are proposed for said district to perform its activities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Whatcom County Council that the duration of Whatcom County Lake Management District No. 1 is hereby extended for a period of an additional seven years, to January 28, 2002, or until a permanent public water supply system is in place for the boundaries of said district, whichever comes first.




