Public Works has approximately 2,150 yards of pea gravel aggregate that has been produced as a byproduct of a screening process that produced sand as the primary product. Since Public Works has no use for the pea gravel, the department is requesting that the County Council declare the gravel surplus so that it may be sold by sealed bid to the highest bidder following the procedures in WCC 1,10.200. The gravel shall not be sold to any County employee or to a member of an employee's immediate family.

15 property of Whatcom County; and




