PRIORITIZING WHATCOM COUNTY PROJECTS FOR THE WASHINGTON
COMMUNITY ECONOMIC REVITALIZATION TEAM (WA-CERT)

WHEREAS, the Washington Community Economic Revitalization Team (WA-CERT) has established pre-application requirements for proposals under the President's Economic Adjustment Initiative for timber impacted communities; and

WHEREAS, the pre-application requirements mandate that the County pass a resolution of support and establish numerical priorities for proposals submitted to WA-CERT for 1996 funding consideration; and

WHEREAS, on April 25, 1995, the Whatcom County Council assigned **Priority 1** to Acme Water District 18 and **Priority 2** to the Bellingham/Whatcom County Convention Bureau; and

WHEREAS, the WA-CERT pre-application instructions state that projects do not have to be ranked in the top three in order to receive funding or technical assistance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Whatcom County Council that the recommended prioritization of all projects received to date are as listed in Exhibit A.


