This is an amendment to the 1997 unrepresented salary resolution that provides for an increase to salaries for Superior Court Commissioners by changing the basis from which their salaries are derived. The proposed amendment changes the Superior Court Commissioners' salary rate to 80% of the Superior Court Judge salary level, instead of 80% of the District Court Judge salary level.

33 Superior Court and District Court Commissioners for 1997 are to be paid at the
34 rate of 80% of the District Court Judge Salary level. Any changes in District Court
35 Judges salaries during 1997 will be reflected in ~~District~~ Court Commissioners'
36 salaries.

38 **AND FURTHER, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Whatcom County Council
39 that the salary changes contained herein are effective on January 1, 1997.


