12 submitted by several qualified voters from the district and are attached herewith as Exhibit A.


13 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, Dick Bedlington,

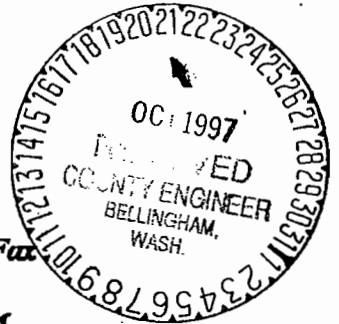
