RESOLUTION NO. 98-057

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF
WHATCOM COUNTY SURPLUS PROPERTY
PURSUANT TO WCC 1.10

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on, August 11, 1998 to discuss the sale of Whatcom County property; and

WHEREAS, it was determined to be in the best interest of Whatcom County to sell the property listed in Exhibit "A" and such property shall be sold by public auction on August 19 or after, subsequent to compliance with the notice requirements of WCC 1.110.; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that where there is no bid within the advertised terms the County may withdraw the property from sale, or if the County deems such action to be in the public interest, reject any or all bids either written or oral, and thereafter negotiate the sale of the property providing the negotiated price is higher than the highest bid at the public sale and that the public has notice by advertisement, under Section 1.10.190, and an opportunity to compete, through mailed bids, for the purchase by offer of a more favorable price


