AMENDING RESOLUTION 97-062 AND RE-PRIORITIZING WHATCOM COUNTY
PROJECTS FOR THE WASHINGTON COMMUNITY ECONOMIC REVITALIZATION
TEAM (WA-CERT)

WHEREAS, the Washington Community Economic Revitalization Team (WA-CERT) has established pre-application requirements for proposals under the President's Economic Adjustment Initiative for timber impacted communities; and

WHEREAS, the pre-application requirements mandate that the County pass a resolution of support and establish numerical priorities for proposals submitted to WA-CERT for 1997 funding consideration; and

WHEREAS, on September 23, 1997, the Whatcom County Council prioritized the most recent set of project proposals; and

WHEREAS, the deadline for submitting a prioritized list of projects to WA-CERT is April 1, 1999; and,

WHEREAS, several of the current prioritized projects have either been funded by WA-CERT or withdrawn from the project list and an updated priority list is needed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Whatcom County Council that the recommended prioritization of all projects received to date is as listed in Exhibit A to this resolution.
