ORDINANCE NO. 2010-031

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING PARKING RESTRICTION
ON LOCUST AVENUE

WHEREAS, Whatcom County Council is authorized under RCW 46.61.570 to restrict parking on certain County roads; and

WHEREAS, Whatcom County Fire Marshal contacted Public Works with the concerns of unsafe parking that would restrict emergency vehicle; and

WHEREAS, Whatcom County Sherriff's office contacted Public works to request assistance in defining parking that could be enforced so emergency vehicles can access; and

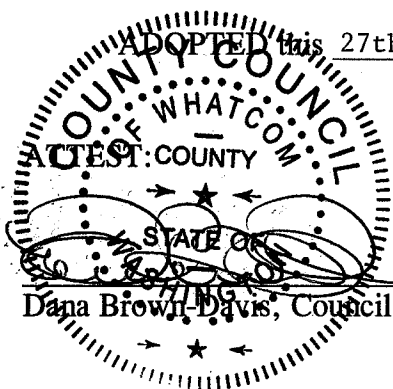
WHEREAS, an engineering study was conducted by the County Engineer's office it was found that the parking was in a manner that was unsafe.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Whatcom County Council that the following be added to the Whatcom County Code Section 10.24 as follows:

No Parking Anytime zone be established on Locust Avenue on the northwest side of the road from the railroad tracks to Marine Drive and on the southeast side from the railroad tracks to 150 feet.


