The Administrative Appeal is appealing a determination made by Planning and Development Services, based on Whatcom County Critical Areas Ordinance, WCC 16.16.205, that the shoreline setback is measured from the top of the bank, rather than the Ordinary High Water Mark. The property in question is located at **1424 Seacrest Drive, Lummi Island, Washington.**~~
