PROCEDURE FOR SOURCE SITE INSPECTION

1. Determine and flag well site choices with consideration given to factors such as setbacks from proposed or existing roads, property lines, lot lines, and buildings. Identify and locate any current or potential sources of contamination such as application or storage of herbicides, pesticides, industrial chemicals, sewer lines, on site septic systems, underground storage tanks, roads, road easements, and existing buildings. Evaluate drainage and flood potential at well site. Consider proposed water system hydraulics, elevations, and reservoir locations.
2. Draw an accurate sketch of the proposed well site area, which includes location of the items mentioned above.
3. Return this application to our office with fee and well site sketch attached. Schedule well site inspection with Health Department.

OTHER GENERAL INFORMATION

This inspection is done by Whatcom County Health Department as stated in WAC 246-290-130. Please be aware that there are additional approval requirements in WAC 246-290-130 that must be met prior to putting the source on line and in some cases, prior to drilling. Depending on the size of the proposed system, these approvals must be obtained from the County or State Health Department and the State Department of Ecology. All sources must have recorded covenants for the sanitary control area under WAC 246-290-135.
