I wish to make a request on one aspect of the Draft Public Participation Plan that was presented to the Planning Commission on April 14.

My request is that the MRL Expansion project (D-10) on page 4-2 be moved from a Level 1 project to a Level 3 project. This expansion will have a profound affect on the Lummi Island Scenic Estates residential community, which is adjacent to the quarry and is regularly affected by dust and noise from it. The Scenic Estates community has over 400 residential lots and has many full time residents. In addition, multiple agencies, i.e. the Department of Ecology, The NW Clean Air Agency and others have found this operation to be in violation of stormwater management regulations, water rights regulations, clean air regulations, and others.

In my opinion, this expansion needs a much closer look and a Level 1 designation is not sufficient to address the issues listed above.
