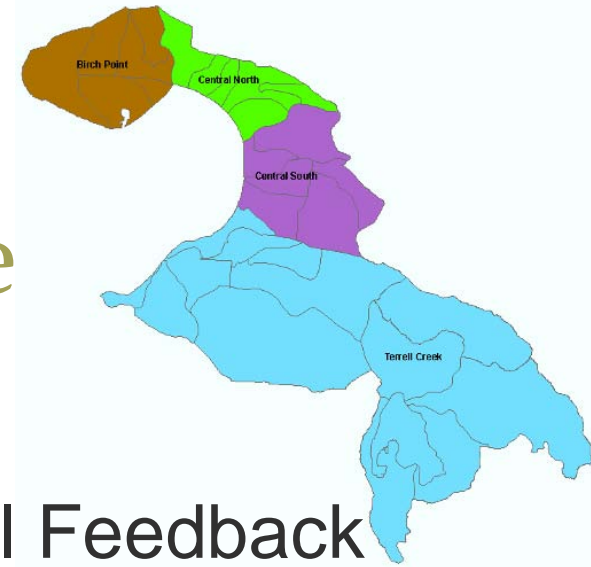

Summary of LID Changes (1)

- Simplify
 - 5 Point Categories
 - One page checklist
 - No tiered benefit level
 - Normal Review Process
 - “Off the Shelf” LID BMPs for small projects
 - Existing definitions

Summary of LID Changes (2)

- Pilot Program
 - Evaluation based on performance 2017
 - Survey of participants

Summary of LID Changes (3)

- Better Incentives
 - Flexible parcel configurations encourages modern residential development
 - Aesthetic stormwater options
 - Free screening meeting
 - Reduced Buffers w/LID
 - Avoidance criteria for “development” watersheds

Summary of LID Changes (4)

- Maintenance Requirements
 - Text and Site Plan recorded with property

Summary of LID Changes (5)

- Publicly Accessible Information
 - Handbook
 - Getting permits
 - Finding Professional help
 - Choosing the right stormwater facility
 - Costs
 - Mitigation Options

Habitat Mitigation Fund/CAO

- Reduced Buffers w/LID and HMF (65-40-65%)
- Impacts on Mainstem Terrell Cr, must be mitigated onsite.
- LID to meet Avoidance/Minimization criteria
 - “Development” watersheds
 - Category III and IV Wetlands
 - Compensatory mitigation to ratios defined in 16.16.680
- Pilot Program to be reviewed 2017
- Checklist of habitat features impacted
