Dear Mr. Mann:

Having reviewed in brief the Foothills Sub-Area Plan, it is my belief that it

does not fairly present the facts connected with the area at all, but is founded

on a great deal of unsupported guesswork and extrapolation.

The nature of the Foothills does not lend itself to the kind of urbanization in

view, nor is there sufficient financial backing and appropriate support for the

move.

The demographic infrastructure of the area (education, social services, protective services (including police, fire, and other emergency needs), library systems, etc. simply do not support such a move without complete (and revealed) individual plans for each to support an "urban area" need and capability.

I strongly recommend the Plan be rejected and reconsidered with an appropriate

base used for the research, proper polling of the populace, and a revealed view

to the social infrastructure support needed to undergird such a development successfully.
