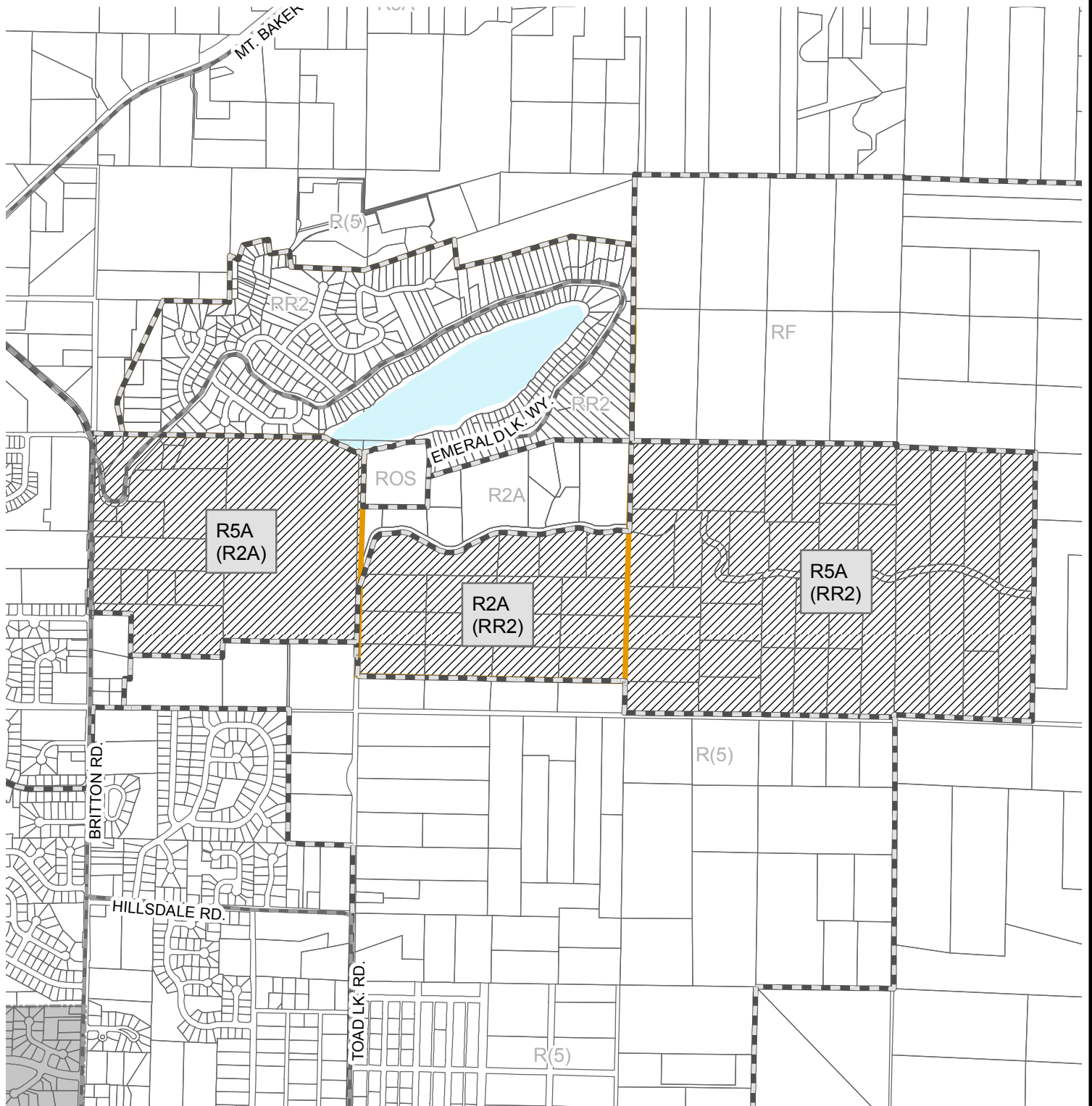

This afternoon I double checked the maps I hastily revised late Tuesday and noticed that the Emerald Lake zoning map had an error. The map did not indicate that the R2A parcels south of the subdivision and north of the current RR2 parcels would remain R2A. I believe it was the intent of the motion that all the area south of the subdivision would be zoned R2A. So I have made the necessary revision to the map (attached) making it clear these parcels would remain R2A, and posted it on the Rural Element web site with a note that it has been reposted today to correct the error.
