



**NOTE:**

1. The paved apron shall be a 2-1/2 inch minimum depth of class 'B' asphalt pavement or approved equivalent. Radius shall be 30 feet minimum and the length of pavement from the road edge shall be 20 feet.
2. The paved apron shall have a minimum 1 foot wide compacted crushed top course shoulder when used with an 18 foot rural private standard road.
3. Culvert installation shall be as shown on Drawing 508.D-1. The Revocable Encroachment Permit will specify the size of the culvert, but will be no less than 12 inch diameter.
4. The edge of the existing pavement shall be saw cut and sealed per Section 512.F.
