Whatcom County Public works would like to inform local residents of upcoming repairs to three sites along the road which sustained damage during the January 2009 storm event.

The design phase is currently underway which includes the environmental permitting process, updating the survey topography, as well as possible geotechnical assessment.

The timeline, weather permitting, is as follows:

Next 2 weeks: The survey crew will be in the area to collect additional survey data of the two settlement areas of the roadway.

Nov. – Dec. 2009: County Forces (Maintenance & Operation) crews will be ditching, installing a culvert and cleaning slide debris from the ditches.

Design of repair for the slide closest to Highway 9 – will be completed. This will go through the competitive bid process at the beginning of the year.

Mar. – May 2010: Construction & repair of all sites will be March-May 2010, depending on weather and environmental permitting.
