### ADJUSTING COUNTY OPERATIONS FOR COVID-19 RECOVERY

**WHEREAS**, Whatcom County sustained the highest possible level of service for citizens during the COVID-19 event; and

**WHEREAS**, enhancement in on-line services, improvements in County facilities, and re-opening plans to match State requirements have allowed many departments to re-open doors for in-person services; and

**WHEREAS**, remaining County offices will re-open for public access in concert with the State of Washington's Roadmap to Recovery; and

**WHEREAS**, each Department Head and Elected Official is empowered to:

1. Determine the methods and staffing for providing essential public services
2. Continue to allow telework opportunities following HR policy

**NOW, THEREFORE, BY** virtue of the power vested in me by the home rule charter for Whatcom County, I hereby rescind Executive Order 2020-01 "Adjusting County Operations During the COVID-19 Event."
