

# EMS Supply Exchange

**First responders may replace the following items used on a patient 1:1 from the transport unit to which a patient has been transferred:**

## Oxygen therapy

- Oxygen bottles - refill/exchange
- BVM and mask
- Rescue pod
- Nasal Cannula
- Non-Rebreather mask
- Suction Tip
- Hand suction bottle (V Vac)
- OPA
- King Tube

## Cardiac

- Defibrillator patches
- ECG Wires

## Splinting/Other

- Pelvic sling
- Speed straps
- Cervical collar
- Head bed
- Tourniquet
- Gurney

## ALS Supplies/Other

- One-for-one like items -- includes medications except controlled drugs.

**Others items that may be replaced if missing or damaged:**

- Gurneys - maintenance and repair
  - Annual Inspections done through County Chiefs Association
- Backboards - exchange, replacement when missing or damaged
- Spider straps - exchange, replacement when missing or damaged
- Vacuum splints - exchange, replacement when missing or damaged
- KTD - exchange, replacement when missing or damaged
- KED - exchange, replacement when missing or damaged
- Combi-Carrier (Clam Board) - exchange, replacement when missing or damaged
- Oxygen bottles -- refill/exchange or damaged

- ❖ First Responders advise transport unit staff of all items taken
- ❖ Transport unit staff advise EMS 1 of any damaged equipment received..
- ❖ Transport Unit staff advise EMS 1 of discrepancies in exchange due to inventory shortage.
